Re: Unaddressed Issues in “Transforming the Future of Ageing” Scoping Paper

Dear Herr Klumpers:

We write today on behalf of the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM)<sup>1</sup> and its Europe Technology Policy Committee with thanks for your past engagement with our members and programs, and an offer to support the Scientific Advice Mechanism in the vital work outlined in its 27 April 2018 Scoping Paper on “Transforming the Future of Ageing” ([Scoping Paper](#)).

We concur fully with the threshold observation in the Scoping Paper’s discussion of challenges and opportunities regarding “healthy ageing” that, “A coherent and focused inclusive, fair and sustainable public health response that spans multiple sectors and stakeholders is important.” To that end, we respectfully note that the Scoping Paper does not address several disciplines and associated policy considerations that may be essential to meeting the Commission’s objectives.

Specifically, the Scoping Paper does not reference the potential centrality to healthy ageing in safety and dignity of either “Privacy by Design” or “Security by Design.”<sup>2</sup> Also, the importance of educating an ageing population in technologies that can enrich life and mitigate isolation, we believe, could and should be included in the SAM’s work in this sphere. ACM and its Europe Technology Policy Committee would be pleased to work with you and the Group of Chief Scientific Advisors to address these potentially important components of promoting healthy ageing.
